Project COLORS Youth Mentorship Program



WHERE: Wilderness, South Africa

WHO: African Youth aged 17-25

HOW LONG: Between 10 days - 2 weeks depending on learner

(Only 2 youth are selected at a time at various times though out the year)

Goal: South African Youth Mentorship - This is an experiential youth leadership program helping youth build CV's, learn new skills, volunteer & learn how to make a difference in their communities. They will leave with direct community development experience and learn from local women how they started their own community projects. Youth will learn from the Yale leadership program manuals, motivational program by Anthony Robbins and build a portfolio on their skills and experiences to present to future employers. They will also leave with a certificate from COLORS on their accomplishments plus receive a memory stick with certificate, CV, reference letter and other self development documents.



The program is geared to build confidence in ones self, learn to think outside the box by coming up with new solutions to community issues and empower youth to aspire to new levels of learning and self development.

In this mentorship program youth will assist with the daily activities of Project COLORS International.

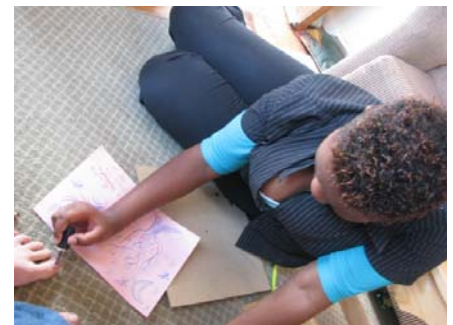
An example of some of the projects we are assisting with include:

Tiny Tummys : Providing toddlers with immune boosting daily nutrition at our pre-schools .

Healthy Happy Pre-schools: Support for struggling care centres through renovations, educational programming, arts & crafts plus sooo much more.

1st Aid & Basic Health: Providing teachers with 1st aid kits for their villages, tooth brushes every 3 months for the children & emergency assistance.

Save a Street Dog: We care for and re-home injured dogs & ailing puppies.



Other projects might come up during the youth program depending on our current projects and funding.

COLORS takes a holistic approach to all our projects.

TERMS:

-Transport to and from COLORS site is paid for by COLORS. However, if a youth is coming from an area far from our site the host NGO sending the youth must 1st pay for their bus ticket which COLORS will re-invoice them with a bank transfer.

-Food and lodging will be provided by COLORS

-100R is given to each youth each week for incidentals

-Youth must abide by rules of respect and accountability. Be on time. Work along community partners. Be safe. Don't let people outside the project onto project site or in intern's apartment.

- After the program, youth must volunteer for one month for a community NGO to gain credibility and 1st hand experience in their own communities in an effort to strengthen their CV's and become more employable.

-Youth will receive a certificate of accomplishment once they complete their volunteer ship.
